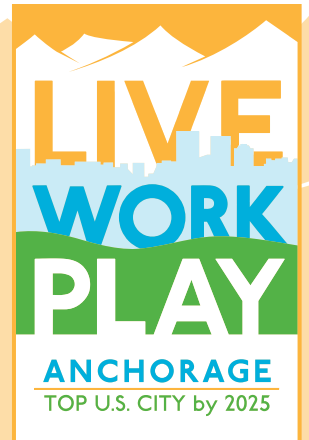


Last year, AEDC's Board of Directors adopted the the live, work, play vision -
